### Master of Science (M.S.) in Information Technology Project Management

People in every industry manage projects. However, as technology has evolved, so has the demand for project managers who can understand and manage the unique needs of an information society.

The U.S. spends \$2.3 trillion on projects every year; an amount equal to one-fourth the nation's gross national product. In the 1990s, U.S. companies spent more than \$250 billion each year on IT projects, but the overall success rate was just 16.2 percent. In 2001, there were more than 500,000 new IT projects alone, up 300,000 from year 2000. All of these factors indicate a growing demand for skilled professionals who are trained in IT project management.
