### Master of Science (M.S.) in Information Technology Project Management

IT project managers are responsible for planning, organizing, creating, and managing the way an organization utilizes computers for business and communication activities.

The job outlook for IT project manager positions is expected to grow approximately 15% from 2012 to 2022, which is *faster than the average* for all occupations. Job growth is expected to be fueled by businesses expanding their use of wireless devices and networks, which creates a need for professionals who can manage these expansions (Bureau of Labor Statistics, U.S. Department of Labor, *Occupational Outlook Handbook, 2016-2017 Edition*).
